Join the Boston Regional Network to End Homelessness, Social Action Ministries of the Massachusetts Housing and Shelter Alliance and the Boston Faith-Based Advisory Council to End Homelessness as we launch an interfaith effort to welcome formerly homeless individuals and families into their new homes.

By becoming a Community Connect Partner, your group will:

- ◆ Be added to a list of faith-based and other community organizations available to partner with service providers who have identified recently housed tenants in your community.
- ◆ Welcome individuals or families into their new homes by providing a welcome basket, including information about local resources, gift cards to grocery or other stores, invitations to local programs and more. Service providers will then be responsible for delivery of the welcome baskets.
- ◆ Provide further opportunities for relationship building and community involvement, if desired by welcome basket recipients, such as welcome dinners, workshops or invitations to other community events.
